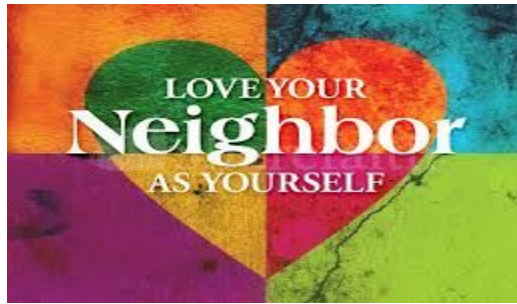


## Reeder News 3rd Grade
