

## 4th Grade Curriculum

**Reading-** Through the use of the Scott Foresman Reading Street curriculum students read and comprehend literature and informational texts. Students learn and apply grade- level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words and read with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension.

**English/Language Arts-** The English and Language Arts curriculum is directly linked to the reading curriculum. Students use the Scott Foresman Spelling and Grammar Worksheets to practice grammar rules and skills.

**Math-** The A beka series is used.

The main ideas for this grade level are as follows:

- (1) developing understanding and fluency with multi-digit multiplication, and developing understanding of dividing to find quotients involving multi-digit dividends
- (2) developing an understanding of fraction equivalence, addition and subtraction of fractions with like denominators, and multiplication of fractions by whole numbers
- (3) understanding that geometric figures can be analyzed and classified based on their properties, such as having parallel sides, perpendicular sides, particular angle measures, and symmetry

**Science-** The Christian based curriculum is from BJU Press. It covers God's Creation, Forces and Energy, The Moon and Oceans, The Earth for Our Use, and The Body at Work.

**Social Studies-** The Social Studies curriculum is from McGraw-Hill. We use Regions: Adventures in Time and Place. It covers United States, Land and People, The Southeast, The Northeast, The Middle West, The Southwest, and The West. Outside resources (ex: [superteacherworksheets.com](http://superteacherworksheets.com) and other sources) are also used to supplement as needed.

**Spelling-** Scott Foresman provides the spelling and vocabulary curriculum within the series.

**Memory-** Each week students memorize a bible verse. They write down the verse on Friday's for a grade.
