For Children of all ages

July 5 - August 3

For any parent who has concerns about their child's speech, language or reading development, I plan to offer summer help for these areas. I am a certified Speech Language Pathologist and previously worked in the Warren County Schools as an SLP. **Services provided:** articulation, language, and reading tutoring. Here is the plan:

Cost: (must commit to at least 4 sessions)

- 5.00 per session for HTLS and summer care students
- 10.00 per session for all other students

30 Minute Therapy/Tutoring Sessions:

Tuesdays and Wednesdays

July 11-12, 18-19, 25-26 and August 1-2
