The students at HTLS love books and our library holds an estimated 15,000 books for them to read and enjoy! The students have been able to visit the library and begin book check-out. Here are some reminders for your child and you about the library and the AR program at HTLS:

Students are checking out 1-2 books a week in their reading level. Please remind your child about proper book care and help them remember, especially if they are younger, to bring their books to school on library day.

Make time for reading each night. Read to your child or with your child. Look for opportunities to read instead of watching tv or using technology.

Ask your child periodically about their book. Who are the characters? Share one exciting part in your book with me. How do you like your book?
