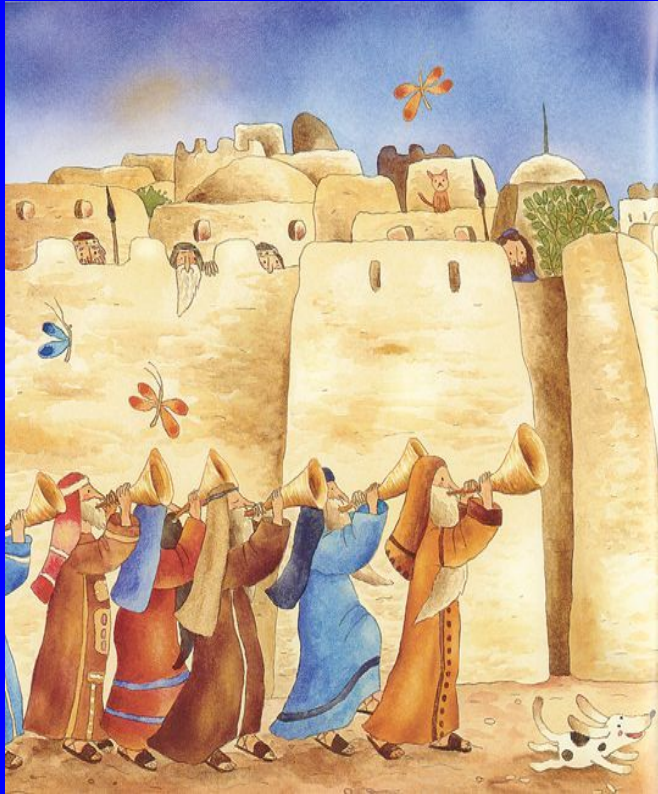


This Week in P3: Lesson 11: Jericho

Our Activities!

- Daily review of our Bible story from Joshua 6.
- Continuing our lesson on transportation by discussing trucks. We will discuss items that can be hauled in trucks and we will discuss why trucks are useful.
- We will review numbers 1-5. Students will be asked to match items with the correct number.
- Students will count trucks within different groups. The students will be asked to circle the group which has 6 trucks.
- Students will be asked to look at color identification in a different way. The students will have to verbalize which fruits are colored incorrectly in a given group.
- Students will be shown an image of Jericho. The children will be asked to identify which items are missing from the image.
- We will begin memorizing our phone numbers. The students will be given a worksheet to take home to continue practicing. (You may also want to begin memorizing the number 911, in case of emergencies!)

Exploring God's Creation!

- Reading: I will be reading a story to the class. We will flip through the pages and discuss what we think is going to happen within the story. Students will be asked what they liked about the story once it is read.
- Shapes: We will view an image of a truck. The children will be asked which shapes they can identify.
- Colors: We will play a game where I will correctly, and incorrectly identify colors. The students will be asked to correctly identify the colors that I missed.
- Music: I will teach the students the song, "Joshua Fought the Battle of Jericho".
- Health and Safety: We will be learning our phone numbers and our parents and caregivers names!
- Creative Cooking: The students will be given a special treat of chocolate chip cookies! The students will count the number of chocolate chips within their cookies!

We will also be having our Operation Christmas Child P3 Packing Party!

"'Cause the battle is in our hands."

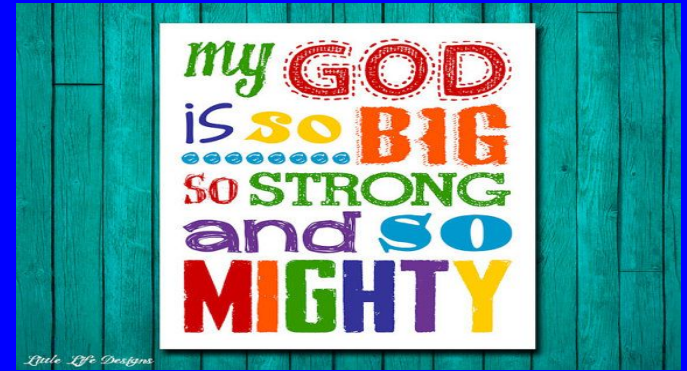
