- We will review our Bible Story by completing a dot-to-dot image of Hannah and her son Samuel.
- The students and I will play with cars and traffic signs on our car rug. We will discuss what each sign means, and practice follow those signs while we play.
- We will also begin practicing our Christmas songs for our HTLS Preschool Christmas Program! Our program will be held Thursday, December 14th at 5:00p.m.

- Praying with **passion**, pouring out our heart and soul to God in honesty and sincerity

Exploring God's Creation!

- **Math-** We will play a number game where I will write numbers 1-5 on the whiteboard. The students will be asked to answer questions by pointing to, or raising their hand and saying the correct number. (Examples: How many eyes do you have?/How many people live in your home?)
- **Arts and Crafts-** We will make paper airplanes and fly them in the gym!
- **Health and Safety-** We will continue working on our phone numbers. We will also discuss the care of infants. This will go along with our story of Hannah and her son, Samuel.
- **Creative Cooking-** We will be enjoying "Stoplight Crackers". Using a rectangular cracker, icing, and M&M's, we will make our own stoplights as a special snack!
