## Lesson 22: The Shepherds Visit Jesus

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### Bible Reference:

Luke 2:8-20

### Bible Concept:

The angels announced Jesus' birth to the shepherds.

### Memory Verse:

Luke 2:11

# Our Activities!

- Daily reading of our Bible story from Luke 2:8-20.
- Our letter focus of the week will be on the letter Hh. The students will trace the letters Hh with their finger or pencil and say the word “hen”. The children will color a picture of a hen.
- We will discuss the difference between things which are alive and not alive. We will identify items such as plants, animals, or people which are alive. We will then discuss items which are not alive such as, a clock, a table, or a shoe.
- The children will be shown pictures of animals and their shadows. The children will have to determine which shadow goes with which animal.
- The students will be asked to identify items which are larger or smaller than a chair.
- The children will be given an image of the nativity scene and will be asked to look and find the objects in the picture that are listed on the side of the image.
- We will do a review of the concept of things which are alive and not alive by doing a sorting activity.

# Exploring God's Creation!

- Science: We will play a game where the students will have to answer whether or not a particular animal walks, swims, or flies.
- Phonics: We will say the word “hen” together emphasizing the beginning /h/ sound. We will make a list of words that have the same beginning sound.
- Math: We will read another book that tells us about the birth of Jesus. I will show the children an image of the angels appearing to the shepherds. Together, we will count the number of angels, shepherds, and sheep we see in the image.
- Colors: We will play a game on the carpet. The children will be asked a series of color questions. For example: “If you are wearing the color red, please stand up.” or “If you are wearing the color blue, please criss-cross your legs.”
- Story Time: The students will be given the opportunity and retell the story of Jesus’ birth and the shepherds’ visit.
- Arts and Crafts: We will begin working on a special Christmas craft!
- Physical Education: We will play “trash ball.” We will use scrap paper and a wastebasket and practice our basketball skills!
