Lesson 7: Plagues

Bible Reference:

Exodus 5:1- 13:6

Bible Concept:

God sent plagues to Egypt so Pharaoh would let the Israelites leave the country.

Memory Verse:

Exodus 6:6

Therefore, say to the people of Israel: 'I am the Lord. I will free you from your oppression and will rescue you from your slavery in Egypt. I will redeem you with a powerful arm and great acts of judgment.'

Our Activities!

- Reading our Bible story from Exodus 5:1-13:16
- Tracing the word “star” with our pointer finger and saying each letter out loud.
Counting the number of points on a star and coloring the picture.
- Exploring the differences between full and empty using glasses of water.
Students will also match clothing items which are the same.
- Counting stars on a picture of the night sky.
- Reexamining the Bible story by looking for the different plagues within a picture.
- The students will make their own night sky by gluing stars onto construction paper.
- We will discuss “The Starry Night”, a painting by Vincent van Gogh, June 1889
- Daily review of our Bible story.

Exploring God's Creation

- Science- We will have several glasses of water available. We will discuss the difference between full and empty. Students will be given the opportunity to identify which glasses are full and which glasses are empty.
- Phonics- Students will be asked to follow a clapping pattern. When students begin to understand this concept, I will introduce one, two, and three syllable words to say while clapping.
- Reading- I will read a book individually with each student. Students will be asked to turn the pages from left to right. We will discuss that how sentences run from left to right.
- Math- Students will be given a number of plastic forks and spoons. Students will match the items and count to see which group has more.
- Shapes- We will discuss a star shape. As a group we will search for stars within our school building. I will also bring in an apple and cut it in half to show the students that the seeds form a star shape inside the apple.
- Colors- We will focus on the colors black and white.
- Music- We will learn the song, "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star."
- Physical Education- Students will practice buttoning and unbuttoning a sweater. This helps develop fine motor skills.
