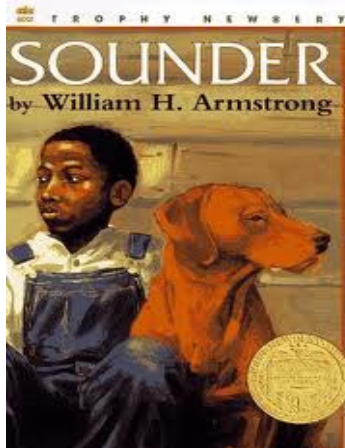
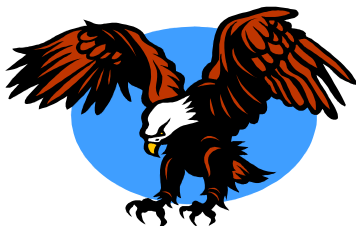


## Reading
